## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

### **What's the story behind the musical "The Best Christmas Pageant Ever"?**

The Herdmans are the worst kids in the history of the world. They lie, cheat, steal, smoke cigars (even the girls), cuss at their teachers and love to clobber other kids. Even worse, this year they're bullying their way into the annual Christmas pageant. Everyone in town is convinced that it will be a disaster. ### **What are the dates, times and location for "The Best Christmas Pageant Ever"?**

7 - 9 p.m. Thursday through Sunday, Dec. 3 - 6 and 10 - 13, in the Worship Center at our Henderson Campus, 55 Al Henderson Blvd., Savannah, GA 31419.

### **How long does the production last?**

The running time is approximately 90 minutes, including a fifteen-minute intermission between the two acts.

### **I'm attending church on Saturday night. How will this production affect the services?**

The 4:30 p.m. Saturday service will be held in the Henderson Worship Center. After the service we'll ask our guests to move to the Coffee Bar in order to reset the Worship Center for the evening production. The 6:15 p.m. Saturday service will be held across the street at the Adult Ministry Center. Since this is an outreach event, we discourage blocking off or reserving seats.

### **Is childcare available?**

"The Best Christmas Pageant Ever" is a family-friendly musical production that best holds the attention of children aged 4 and above. Childcare is not provided.

### **How can I get tickets for "The Best Christmas Pageant Ever"?**

General admission tickets cost \$5 each (children aged 5 and under are free) and can be purchased at SavannahChristian.com, at The Source bookstore and at the door. Tickets are nonrefundable and nontransferable. A \$20 family maximum is available if tickets are purchased at SCC's The Source Bookstore (912-629-4730). There are no group rates or discounted tickets.
